And the wagon the horse drawn wagon was success too but the driver and owner got sick and had to leave. Even though there was a lot of people wanting to get on. It's terrible. We had new three new adoptions of trade name we had sweet chains, which is a thrift store on Thompson road. We had probably burning games map trainings as an online business dispensing. They dispense medical instructions. And we add pine can cut pine constructors. They do roofing siding. We commented and updated on TBA. We talked about grants we did approve a sale of land that's going to help us with the the turntable at the train wreck Park we're going to reconstruct a big stone turntable where the train is used to turn around. Well you know when you have a town like this, you you highlight your strengths. We don't have much. We have parks, we have hiking trails, we have bike trails,

and we have the famous train crash site. So that's what we're doing. Then, the natural bear that chug Epic is coming March 24. The reason we highlight this part of our economic development Yeah, but the reason we bring it to you is because they're expecting something like 1000 riders so if you have a business, especially a storefront business, maybe a restaurant, it's a time to have specials they're in town for sometimes you know a couple of days. Have some restaurant specials, give away coupons, get them to come back into town. You know, it's something a lot of them, they come in, they breeze out and never come back because they don't know what's here. We're still doing our workshops for revitalizing the downtown core. A lot of the work has to do with Main Street. We're talking to Rhiannon about it earlier. She used to live right across from Superior bakery so it was superior bakery is sold. It's going to be rental units. It's going to be office space. The old tea building across the street is gutted. That will be part of our business incubator and the meetings we have monthly. We're talking about permaculture perma culture garden, planting all kinds of plantings and fruits and revitalizing the whole acreage around the house. So we have monthly workshops on on that and that's about it except the track at the high school. The project so I'll find out it's moving forward. There's been a contractor hired so we'll have a new track. They're hoping that it's important so they can invite other schools and towns to use the Thompson track. Again, get people into town.
